<u>WALK THROUGH THE BIBLE</u> This week, I summarise **GALATIANS** which is thought by many to be the earliest of Paul's letters and unique in so far as it is addressed to many churches rather than just one. The Galatians were of Celtic Stock having left their native Gaul (France) because of Roman pressure. There is severe pressure here to insist on works being a vital part of earning salvation. This is strongly resisted by Paul in this letter. He insists that the law is there to lead us to Christ where we can be justified by faith in him
